Tronox titanium dioxide is acceptable for use as a colorant in indirect food contact and food packaging applications in accordance with FDA 21 CFR 178.3297 (colorants for polymers) guidelines. Additionally, Tronox titanium dioxide products are suitable for use under 21 CFR 175.300 (resinous and polymeric coatings), 21 CFR 176.170 and 180 (paper and paperboard in contact with aqueous, fatty, and dry food), 21 CFR 177.1520 (olefinic polymers), 21 CFR 175.105 (adhesives), and 21 CFR 177.2600 (rubber articles intended for repeated use) according to regulation limitations.

Please note that Tronox titanium dioxide pigment is not suitable for use as a direct additive in foods, cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, tobacco products, or medical applications. Tronox does not currently offer and titanium dioxide products that meet requirements for use as a direct food additive and will not knowingly sell product into these end use applications.
